Access to City Employment

On April 7th, Positive Resource Center hosted **Jennie Hua** and **Stephen Dempsey** from the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) in our state-ofthe-art Computer Lab. Jennie and Stephen were here representing SFDPH's Access to City Employment (ACE) Program. They were overseeing on-site applications for four Health Worker positions to eligible PRC clients.

The ACE Program was established as a pathway for people with disabilities to access entry levels job in the city and county of San Francisco so that they may be hired on a probationary basis to qualify for the jobs.
