“RuPaul’s Drag Race” Star and Activist Honey Mahogany to Be Honored with Vanguard Leadership Award at PRC’s “Mighty Real” Gala Saturday, November 5 at the Four Seasons Hotel San Francisco

Awardees also Include Tito’s Handmade Vodka and Bare Chest Calendar

SAN FRANCISCO (Sept. 22, 2021) – Ready for things to get mighty real fun? **Honey Mahogany** – San Francisco native, entertainer and LGBTQ+ rights activist – leads the honorees at [PRC’s “Mighty Real”](#) fundraising gala on Saturday, November 5, 6:00 pm, at the Four Seasons Hotel San Francisco. Proceeds from the gala benefit PRC, the San Francisco-based nonprofit providing comprehensive services to the City’s most vulnerable. “Honey has brought light into our lives with her beautiful voice – whether she is using it to support important causes or singing on ‘[RuPaul’s Drag Race](#),’” said **PRC CEO Brett Andrews**. “Her work with those in need across San Francisco has always been unwavering, and we’re thrilled to honor her commitment with our Vanguard Leadership Award. A San Francisco native, Honey is one of us. Her loyalty and passion set an example for all.”

San Francisco native **Honey Mahogany** is an American activist, politician, drag performer and singer. She first came to national attention on the fifth season of “RuPaul’s Drag Race”. Her debut EP is titled *Honey Love*. She is the first Black trans-identified person to serve on the San Francisco Democratic County Central Committee, of which she is now the elected chair. Honey is the co-founder of the Compton’s Transgender Cultural District in San Francisco, where she served as the first director.

PRC’s **Vanguard Leadership Award** is presented annually to a visionary leader who challenges the status quo and inspires PRC to pursue its mission, goals and objectives. PRC celebrates Honey Mahogany’s public service within the LGBTQ+ community in San Francisco. Mahogany joins the company of past Vanguard Leadership Award honorees, including Project Open Hand former executive director Tom Nolan and AIDS Walk founder Craig Miller.
