## SONGS OF THE SEASON RECAP






After more than 24 years of commitment and dedication, and serving thousands of people, Lee Harrington is retiring as of December 31, 2021. In recognition of his many years of service, Lee has been sainted as a Mistress of Saints from The Sisters Of Perpetual Indulgence, received a Lifetime of Service congressional award from Senator Scott Weiner, and received a Hero Award from the HIV/AIDS Provider Network. Lee will be deeply missed by everyone here at PRC, but we look forward to hearing about how he's enjoying this next chapter in life after service.


## THINK OF PRC'S CLIENTS THIS GIVING SEASON
