CARE (Comprehensive AIDS Resource Emergency Act)

CARE is a program funded by a grant awarded by the city and county of San Francisco to help assist patients living with HIV/AIDS to pay for dental services.

UOP was awarded the grant in 1990 and has maintained the grant since then. The program has helped thousands of CARE patients receive dental work while providing experience for our students

Eligibility Requirements

The school's CARE (HIV) Clinic funds dental care for qualified patients through the Ryan White Federal CARE grant.

HIV/AIDS letter of diagnosis signed by a physician or a nurse practitioner.

San Francisco resident.

We verify this by obtaining a copy of one of the following: utility bill, copy of lease agreement or mortgage, a public assistance letter, or an affidavit stating residency in San Francisco.

- Yearly income of \$72,900 (pre-adjusted gross income) or less. This is based on the 2023 Federal Poverty Level.
 - We verify this by obtaining a copy of one of the following: paycheck stub, income tax return, letter from Social Security showing monthly income, bank statement, written financial statement, affidavit stating a lack of income.
- Valid photo identification c
